MobyMax

We will be starting MobMax next week. Throughout the month of November, the children will take introductory tests in Math, English, and Reading to make sure they begin the lessons at their level. These tests will count as their MobyMax minutes for the month of November. After the tests are completed, we will take a bit of time during November to explain the expectations for 5th grade. This will be the 3rd year 5th grade has used MobyMax as an intervention, and we've found it extremely helpful if the children try hard. More information will come home towards the end of November explaining the requirements for December.

Math On-Line Practice Test

To encourage the children to study in advance for the math test, we have decided to offer an incentive. If they earn a 94% or higher on the on-line practice test they will take in school on Tuesday, they don't have to take the real test the next day. There is an **At-Home Practice Test** assigned right now. The **At-Home Practice Test** is **not** required; it's just an extra opportunity to practice. The **In-School Practice Test** they will take on Tuesday will count as a homework grade no matter what grade they earn. If they don't get a 94% or higher on the **In-School Practice Test** on Tuesday, they will need to take the paper-pencil math test on Wednesday.
